

Earthworm Questions

1. Annelida means that is the phylum of the earthworm. It means "ringed" and refers to the rings of the worm.
2. The earthworm has five aortic arches instead of a heart.
3. After it mates with another earthworm, the earthworm's cocoon is formed in the egg capsule or clitellum. It's in the ovaries then it passes through the genital pores.
4. The earthworm's intestine is $\frac{2}{3}$ of the body length.
5. The nervous system is responsible for responses to stimuli, specifically nervous impulses.
