54% of teachers own bicycles: as riders, 19% describe themselves as beginners; 56% describe themselves as moderate; 25% describe themselves as experienced 61% of teachers would like to see bike racks at Digital Harbor High School The #1 reason teachers do not commute to school by bicycle is because their commute is too long The #2 reason teachers do not commute to school by bicycle is because of traffic and driver behavior
